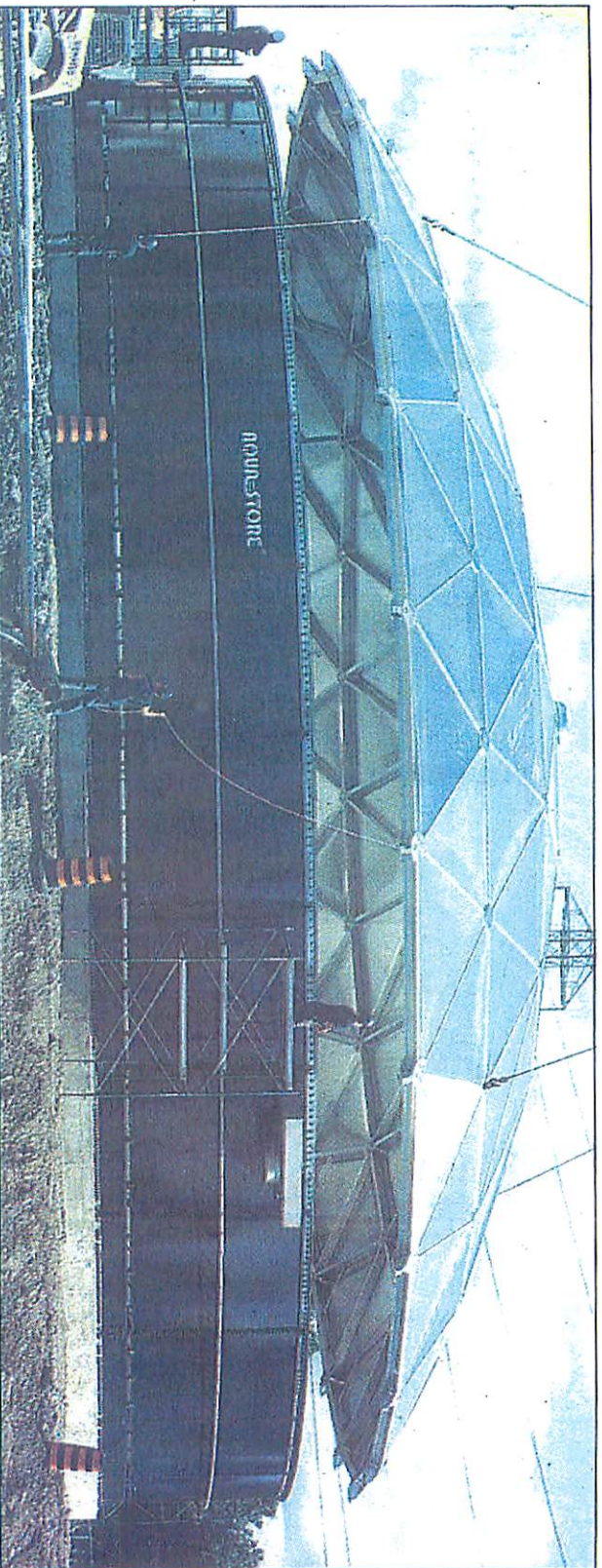


## SPACE-AGE CONTAINER



Workers hold guide ropes as the cap of a new water tank being built for Utilities Kingston on O'Connor Drive was slowly lowered into place by a crane recently. The tank, which will provide additional storage space, will contain 8,200 cubic metres of water once completed. It is about 28 metres in diameter and will be 14 metres high once the lower portion of the tank is jacked up and additional sections are added on on the bottom. The tank is made of glass-fused steel and will never need repainting.
